Kids Camp 1

June 5-8, 2023

Early Bird: **\$200** by April 7

Regular: **\$210** after April 7

Late: **\$220** after May 12

Kids Camp 2

June 12-15, 2023

Early Bird: **\$200** by April 14

Regular: **\$210** after April 14

Late: **\$220** after May 19

Kids Camp 3

July 24-27, 2023

2 night:

Early Bird **\$170** -by May 26- Early Bird **\$200**

Regular **\$180** -after May 26- Regular **\$210**

Late: **\$190** -after June 30- Late: **\$220**

Lee Lodge hotel room preference:

Add **\$15** more per person

DEPOSITS

-Deposits for all Kids Camps are **\$50 per person** and due when you register.

-Deposits are **non-refundable**.

-The number of campers expected when you pay a deposit, is the number you must meet at camp, or you **forfeit** deposits. ***They do not roll over to the remaining balance.***

(ex: 20 deposits paid, 15 arrive at camp, 5 deposit forfeitures)

-Deposits must accompany the initial Hold Form for camp. Without payment we will not reserve spaces for your church.

-Deposits and final payments for camp must be made by the church. We will not accept individual payments by a parent.

REGISTRATION—Begins Feb. 1, 2023

(For churches that pre-registered last year, registration opens to you Jan. 4)

-All parts of registering your church and individual campers are to be completed **online** at www.talltimbersbcc.org on the specific camp page.

-The initial Group Hold information (church name, contact info, numbers) is to be submitted by the church contact.

-All individual camper information and required forms may be completed by parents using an account for the registration software, or by the church contact.

-Each camper attending with your church must be entered in the online registration with all parts completed. Campers not entered before the **Regular** and **Late** registration dates listed above will incur additional charges.

-Names & forms submitted after Late registration date will not be guaranteed t-shirts.

-Church should provide 1 adult male per 10 male students and 1 adult female per 10 female students. Your primary adult leader for each gender must be, at minimum, 21 years of age.
